

GA advises on IPO of IndoChina Capital Vietnam

IndoChina Capital Vietnam was the first Vietnam focused company to be listed on the main London market when it floated last week with assistance from Gavin Anderson.

The account team included GA's chief executive Fergus Wylie, Charlotte Stone and Alexandra Westburg.

The company was seeking to raise was \$350m but due to heavy demand ended up raising \$500m.

ICV, a closed-ended fund, will invest primarily in the securities of companies organised or listed in Vietnam and the securities of companies outside of Vietnam with material operations, assets or income from Vietnam.

Peter R. Ryder, director of ICV, said: 'As the first Vietnam focused company to list on the Main Market of the London Stock Exchange, we are very pleased with the success of our Placing and the status a London main market listing brings to IndoChina Capital Vietnam. The demand for ICV shares demonstrates the appetite for the strong growth that is forecast for the Vietnamese market'.
